

Dr. Terry Mortenson's Lectures

1. "The Age of the Earth: What Does It Matter?" (Saturday, June 14, 2019, 9:15 a.m.)
Many Christians today think that the question of origins (and especially the age of the earth) is an unimportant side issue, which can distract us from focusing on Christ and the gospel and over which we can just "agree to disagree." But is this correct thinking? Dr. Mortenson presents some of the Biblical, theological and scientific reasons for believing that this issue is *vital* important for every Christian, because what ultimately is at stake is the authority of Scripture and the Gospel.
2. "Big Bang: Exploding the Myth" (Saturday, June 14, 2019, 7:30 p.m.)
In a way that is understandable for lay people and teens, this lecture presents many scientific and biblical reasons for why we do not need to bow the knee to the big bang theory or any other theory of cosmic evolution (and the associated billions of years). Quotes by prominent secular astrophysicists reveal that evolutionists really have no idea how any of the planets, stars or galaxies came into existence and that the big bang theory is fraught with scientific problems, to say nothing of being impossible to harmonize with Scripture. We can and should believe the Genesis account of the origin of the universe.
3. "Millions of Years: The Idea's Unscientific Origin and Catastrophic Consequences" (Friday, June 15, 2019, 9:15 a.m.)
To understand what is wrong with belief in millions of years, we need to go back to the early 19th century and study the origin of this idea. This unique lecture, based on Dr. Mortenson's Ph.D. research, will clearly show that the idea was not the result of just letting the rocks and fossils "speak for themselves" but rather comes from anti-Biblical worldviews (or philosophical assumptions) being imposed on the geological evidence. The talk explains the key men who helped develop the idea of millions of years, the various ways that Christians responded, and the subsequent catastrophic consequences of the church's compromise with millions of years. Even non-Christians will find this lecture thought-provoking.
4. "Ape-men, Adam and the Gospel" (Friday, June 15, 2019, 7:30 p.m.)
Evolutionists work hard to convince us that man evolved from ape-like creatures, and an increasing number of theologians and other Christian leaders believe this. Consequently, some of those Christian leaders are also teaching the church that there never was a literal Adam and a literal Fall but that this does not affect the truth of the gospel. Using both scientific evidence and the Bible, Dr. Mortenson exposes the lie of human evolution and the disastrous consequences with respect to racism, morality and the gospel, as a result of denying the literal truth of Genesis.
